RE: COVID-19 update

Dear Residents,

On Monday, Cass County Commission issued new COVID-19 recommendations. Among several recommendations, they strongly recommend masks be worn in public and to avoid groups of more than 10 people. City Hall is also requesting that visitors doing business in City Hall wear a mask.

The Arrowhead Yacht Club has had preemptive guidelines in place. All employees have their temperature taken when they report to work. The employees are also told if they feel sick to stay home. Many tables were removed back in April for social distancing. When a member arrives, they can ask the host to have their service person wear a mask while serving them. All carryout orders should be delivered to your car by an employee wearing a mask.

I am now asking that members please wear a mask when entering the AYC. Once they are seated, they can remove their masks if they choose. In addition, if you leave your seat to use the restroom please put on your mask while walking to and from the restroom.
